## DAY 1

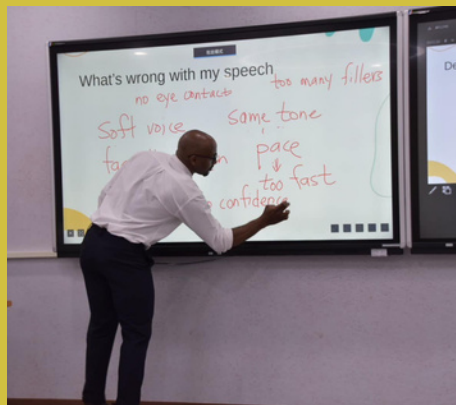

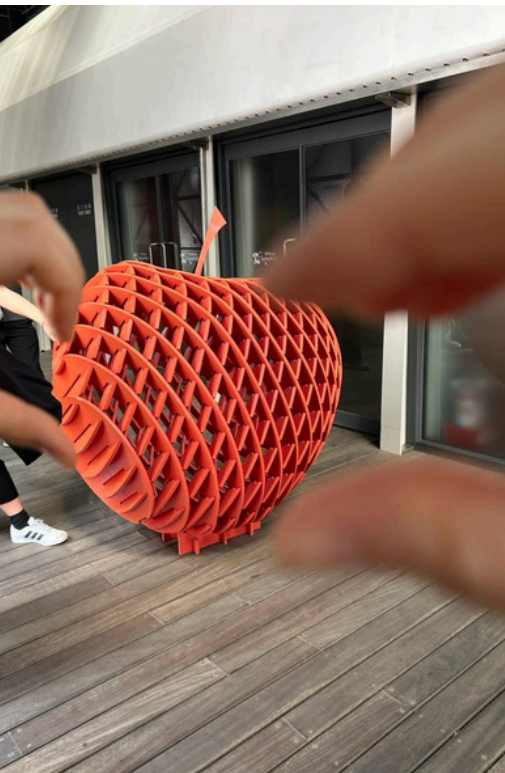
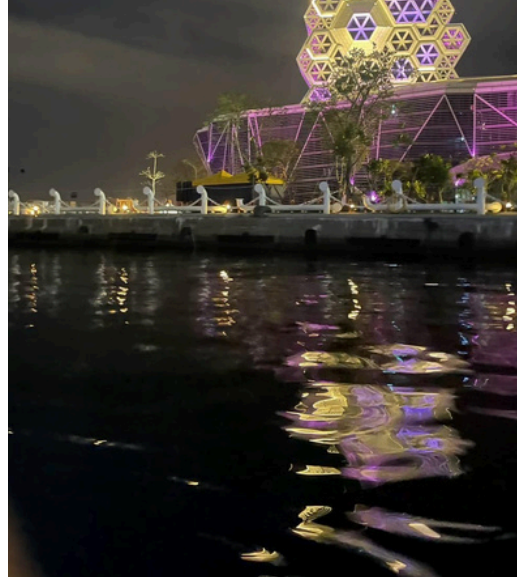
# PRESENTATION DAY

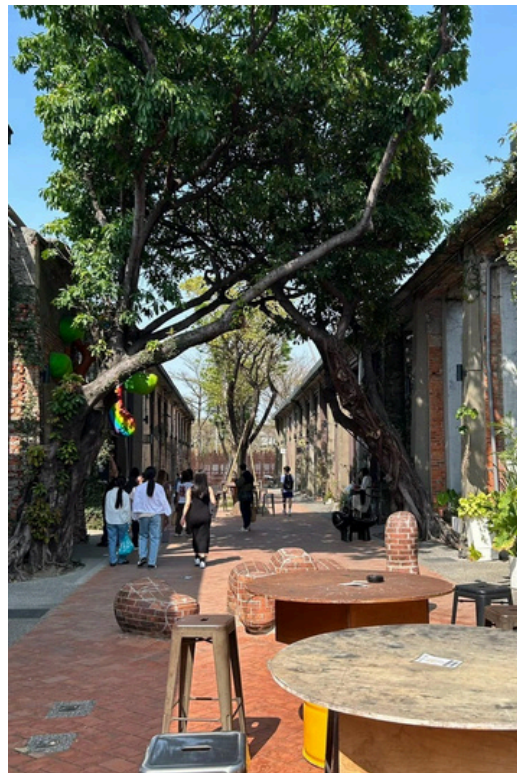
