#### Why was this study conducted?

• Suicide rates among celebrities are increasing. (Kristina Robb-Dover, 2020)

• Since 2000s: more than 100 influencers took their own life. (Lydia, February 2023)

 Lyrics embody a form of storytelling and emotional exploration. (Ussolichah et al., 2021)

• No researches have been done about rapper Lil Nas X while negative words keep appearing in the lyrics.


Focus on the mental risks of Lil Nas X brought out by his comparable life obstacles

#### Method

#### Corpus-based discourse analysis:

- Voyant
- Gathering text data from Lil Nas X's lyrics, real-life statements from past interviews, and official channels.
- Conducting corpus analysis and compare with previous psychological studies.

- ✓ The song lyrics include signs of mental illness, suicidal idea, and references to death and departure.
- ✓ Frequent presence of negative words, death, leave, and away in the lyrics.
- ✓ 9 past events coincided with 7 risk factors for mental illness by Centers for Disease
  Control and Prevention (CDC).

• 2021: many words with negative context appeared: "die", "anxious", "fear", Before the fame "dead", "mistake",... 

#### **Contribution**

- ✓ Words uses: a clear demonstration of his poor mental health
- ✔ Bracing the statement: experiencing an adverse childhood life clearly affected the process of molding an individual's personality and thoughts, or led to mental illness
- ✔ Providing: a better understanding of the relationship between negative music and the psychological darkness of music creators and celebrities
- ✓ Contributing to similar future discourses in the broader context of the music industry and celebrity culture
